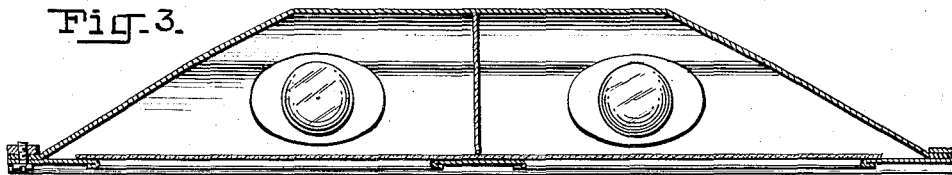
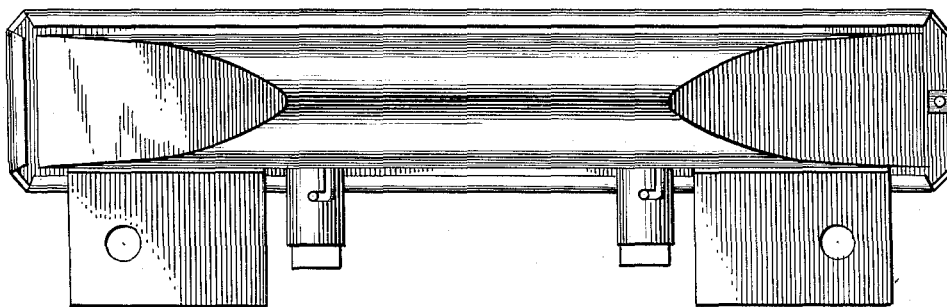
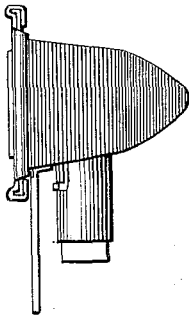
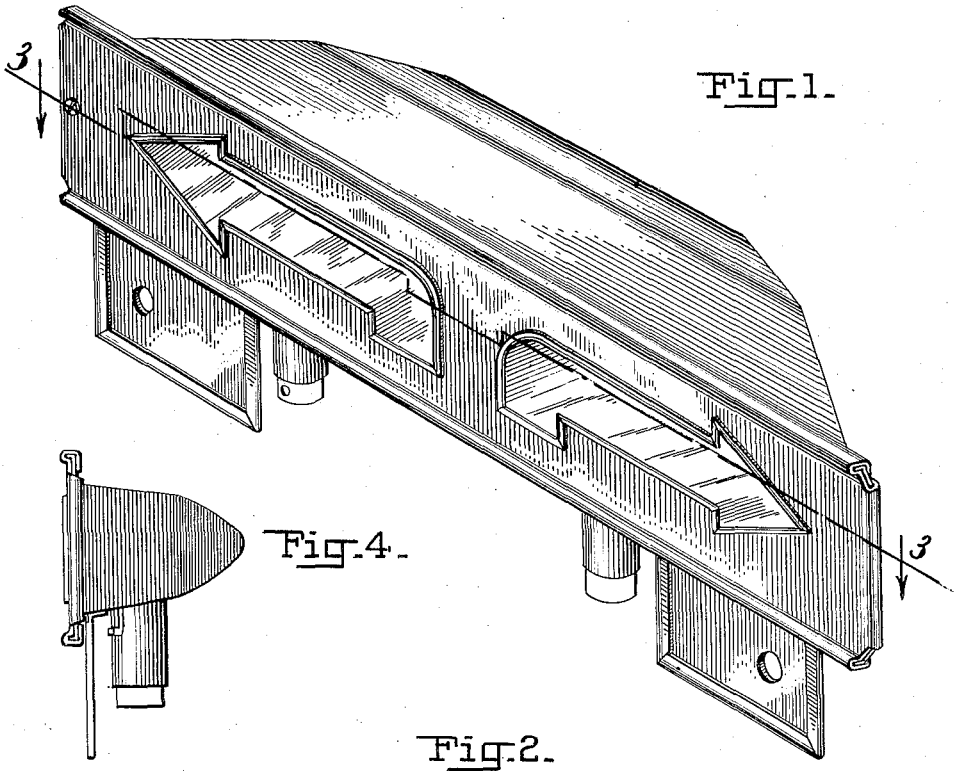

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James M. Lee, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newton Grove, in the county of Sampson and State of North Carolina, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Signal Device, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a signal device showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear view in elevation.

Figure 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3—3 of Figure 1, and looking in the direction of the arrows.

Figure 4 is an end view thereof.
